

## ANNUAL VALENTINES DAY TOUR & LUNCH



### Tour will be held Weather Permitting

AROO's Annual Valentines Day Tour will be on Sunday February 13th - weather permitting - meeting at 9:30 AM, departing at 10:00 AM and arriving at 12:30 PM for an optional no-host lunch.

Join us for a leisurely 80 mile, 2 hour tour from Beaverton to a no-host lunch at Camp 18 Restaurant, via Bald Peak and Laurelwood. We will see some of the usual roads, perhaps in the opposite direction instead, and maybe a few new ones too! All roads will be paved, and hopefully clear of winter debris.

### Tour Departure:

When: Arrive by 9:30 AM, drivers meeting to follow, departure at 10:00 AM sharp.

Where: Near Starbucks at 11405 Beaverton-Hillsdale Hwy, Beaverton, OR 97005 in the parking lot of the Fred Meyer Shopping Center just west of Hwy 217, between Canyon Road (to north) and Beaverton-Hillsdale Hwy (to south). We will meet in the parking area south of the Starbucks and east of the Wells Fargo Bank.

Food and beverage are available at both Starbucks and Einsteins; restrooms available at both and at Fred Meyers.

Fuel is available on Canyon Road (both Shell and Chevron).

We will have a mandatory driver's meeting and then we will depart from parking lot promptly thereafter.

When: 10:45 AM, 20 minute stop

Where: Bald Peak State Park

Bald Peak State Park restrooms should be open.

### Tour Destination:

When: 12:30 PM estimated arrival

Where: Camp 18 Restaurant, 42362 Hwy 26, Elsie, OR 97138

No-Host Lunch - for those who wish to stay to eat, your meal will be ordered individually off of the menu; it may be busy, so plan to relax and enjoy the wait!
